- 24<sup>th</sup> International Epilepsy Congress in Buenos Aires 2001 Launch of phase 2 of the Global Campaign Against Epilepsy
- 2001 in Geneva
- Albania, Armenia, Arzerbaijan, Estonia, Honduras, Jamaica, Kyrgyzstan, Iraq, Lebanon, Malta, Malaysia, Nepal, Paraguay, Philippines, Oatar, Senegal, Syria, South Korea and Zimbabwe join the ILAE, making a total of 81 chapters 2001
- 1st ILAE Chapter Convention takes place at the 5th European 2002 Regional Congress in Madrid
- 2003 25th International Epilepsy Congress - in Lisbon with 2887 delegates
- Belgium, Hong Kong, Kenya, Mongolia and South Africa join 2003 the II AF
- Pregabalin launched into clinical practice in Europe for 2004 epilepsy

- 2005
- 26<sup>th</sup> International Epilepsy Congress in Paris with 5060 delegates
- Bangladesh, China, Costa Rica, Cyprus, Kazakhstan, 2005 Nicaragua, Pakistan, Singapore and the United Arab Emirates join the ILAE
- Epilepsy Atlas published under the auspices of the Global 2005 Campaign Against Epilepsy
- 2006 1st regional vice-president is elected - from the Asian and Oceanian Region
- 27<sup>th</sup> International Epilepsy Congress in Singapore with 2900 delegates 2007
- 2007 Uganda and New Zealand join the ILAE
- 2007 Stiripentol licensed for use in SMEI in Europe
- 2007 Rufinamide licensed for use in Lennox–Gastaut Syndrome in Europe
- Epilepsia introduces publication of articles on-line before the 2007 print edition, themed issues and the Gray Matters section
- 2007 Morris-Coole prize initiated 2007
- Digitised archive of all Epilepsia articles from 1909 becomes available online
- 1st Congress of the North American region in Seattle 2008
- Lacosamide introduced into clinical practice in Europe 2008 Six new chapters proposed, Guinea, Ghana, Vietnam, Palestine, Mali, Uzbeckistan – bringing the total number of chapters to over 100 2009
